The pebble seats were created by Cornish sculptor Ben Barrell who casts them from concrete and polishes them until they gleam and look like pebbles that you could pick up and skim across the water's surface. But only if you had very big hands...

• Head towards the Pavilion and then towards the harbour bridge

#### **DID YOU KNOW...**

Agatha Christie used to enjoy roller skating on the pier when she was a young woman. In fact the pier was constructed in the year she was born (1890) and once had a concert hall and the Island Showbar on the end. Sadly they were destroyed in a fire in 1974.

### 5. HARBOUR BRIDGE GOAT.SPIT.AMUSE

#### **DID YOU KNOW...?**

The bridge was built as part of a £21 million harbourside development at the start of the 21st century. The inner harbour used to be tidal and every low tide would become a sludgy mess. Now it is kept perpetually at mid tide by metal underwater gates. When the bridge lifts, these gates are simultaneously lowered to allow boats safe passage.

## 6. HARBOUR RING HARRY.DINED.AUTHOR

#### **DID YOU KNOW...?**

There is a piece of civic art here created by Bob Budd to commemorate the brave troops who left here as part of the D-Day landings. If you stand on the cross of lights and look towards the steel ring, you will be looking in the direction that the troops left the slipways. In the wooden floor is a secret message made from lighting units that spells out VANISHING POINT in Morse Code to remember the brave men who didn't return.

Walk along Victoria Parade towards the clock tower

• Continue towards the slipway and walk through tunnel by Visitor Information Centre.

• Cross the road by the Torbay Hotel and walk towards Royal Terrace Gardens (Rock Walk)

# 9. START OF ROCK WALK CAVE.EMPLOY.PIRATE

• Cross over the road at the crossing at the end of Royal Terrace Gardens (Rock Walk)

#### **10. WISHING WELL** FEND.CODES.DATING

• Walk back along seafront and cross road at crossing towards Abbey Refreshments

### **11. ABBEY REFRESHMENTS** COMICAL.NAILS.SCARED

• Walk between the pitch and putt and bowling lawn

### **12. ABBEY GATES** DEED.TITLE.SNAPS

• Walk between the pitch and putt and bowling lawn
